Eligibility for a scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 shall be awarded and limited to a current year 2019-2020 graduating high school senior **who is the grand-child or great grand-child of a PAID Ahrens Trade High School Alumni Association Member.**

This award will be given on the basis of ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE or/GPA, SCHOOL EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES, COMMUNITY-ORIENTED SERVICE, RELIGIOUS AND/OR VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES AND RECOMMENDATIONS BY SCHOOL COUNSELOR/OFFICIAL OR MEMBER OF THE TEACHING STAFF, AND ESSAY AND VERIFICATION OF ELIGIBILITY.

All scholarships are in the form of certificates of award conditioned upon the enrollment of the student in an undergraduate course in an accredited college, university, trade or vocational school. Upon receipt of an invoice for enrollment from proper officials by the Ahrens Trade HS Alumni Association Scholarship Committee, an Ahrens Trade High School Alumni Association check for the amount of the award will be forwarded to the college, university, trade or vocational school to be applied to the student's account. This scholarship shall not be used for any purposes other than tuition. NOTE!!! There will be no exceptions to the means of disbursement of this award. ALSO!!! Pell Grant Recipients Take Note: Review the specific requirements for Pell Grants to make sure this scholarship award does not impact or cause loss of funds from the Pell Grant.

ENCLOSE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WITH THIS FORM:

1. A current picture of yourself (at least 5x7 suitable for publication). This picture will not be returned.
2. The Statement of Eligibility properly completed and notarized. (see page 6)
3. A copy of your high school transcript containing all of your junior and senior semesters. Transcript must contain GPA, credits, and days missed during the senior year.
4. A brief summary of your school, community-oriented and/or religious activities and accomplishments, your educational objectives, and any additional information that you believe qualifies you for this award.
5. A letter of endorsement from at least one of the following: School Counselor or Official, or member of the teaching staff from your high school (on school letterhead or notarized).
6. An essay of 500 words or LESS describing your personal and educational goals for the future, your need for financial assistance, if any, and any personal challenges you may anticipate in furthering your education. Grammar, punctuation and content will be considered. It is suggested applicant should have the essay previewed by a school counselor, teacher or member of the school staff.

All information will be kept strictly confidential, except for essay and 5x7 picture, which we may want for publication in our newsletter.
